
Hungry? You are never out of luck when you come to Woodland United Methodist Church!

36064 - This is the youngest supper club and is made up of a mix of singles and couples, many of whom have young children. A nursery is provided at the church and the group usually meets the third weekend of the month.

Prime Time - This group of middle-age to senior adults meets the 3rd Thursday of each month.

Leftovers - This group lives up to its name....it is made up of those who weren't in any other supper club!

3N1 - This relatively new group mixes all ages into a rotating supper club. Three groups are formed each year with the members rotating in and out until everyone has had a chance to mingle with each member. A large social is planned at the end of the year for the entire group.

Another supper club has been formed for those who fall in the the gaps between 36064, Leftovers, and Prime Time. The group is yet to name itself.

All supper clubs meet monthly.

Ongoing opportunities for nourishment

Sunday School - Classes are offered at 9:15 a.m. and 10:30 a.m. We have classes for every age group and learning style, from book studies to discussion groups to traditional Bible studies. Pick up a brochure to learn more.

Women's Bible Study - This group meets every Tuesday 10 - 11 a.m. This Fall we will finish up the book Conversation Peace by Mary Kassian.

Ladies Morning Circle - These ladies meet the 4th Thursday of each month during the school year.

Firm Believers - This is an exercise group that meets Monday - Wednesday - Friday 9 a.m. - 10 a.m.

Boot Camp for Adults - Saturday morning boot camp happens every Saturday from 9 a.m. - 10 a.m. Cost is \$5 per session.

Kid's Fit - Saturday morning boot camp for kids every Saturday from 9 a.m. - 10 a.m. Cost is \$5. Ages 5-10.

Men's Prayer Breakfast - These men meet on the 2nd Sunday each month during the school year (do not meet June-August or December) at 7:15 a.m.

Hilltoppers - This group of senior adults meets the second Tuesday of each month at 10:00 a.m. for lunch and fellowship. (Fellowship Hall)

Lunch Bunch - This group meets at 11:30 a.m. on the 4th Monday of every month at a local restaurant and is open to any adult.

Grief Support – Living with Grief meets the 1st Monday of each month at 6:30 p.m. in the Church Parlor. Understanding Your Grief meets every Tuesday at 6:30 p.m. in the Church Parlor. (For more info see Paula Lansdon)

Adult Classes

Disciple I - Disciple is a program of disciplined Bible study aimed at developing strong Christian leaders.

The study gives the Old and New Testaments equal time, emphasizing the wholeness of the Bible as a revelation of God. Disciple draws upon the work of scholars, the personal Bible reading and study of the participant, and dynamic group discussion to aid understanding of the Bible.

Disciple III - The driving idea in this study is the connection between memory and identity as the people of God. Participants in this thirty – two week study will read the major and minor Old Testament prophets, with the exception of Daniel, and will read the thirteen Letters traditionally attributed to Paul. To establish the historical context in which the prophets spoke for God, daily reading assignments draw also on the books of Deuteronomy through Chronicles. Spiritual Disciplines - We practice spiritual disciplines because we long for a deeper connection with God. The spiritual disciplines open the doors to a fuller and more meaningful life in Christ. Join us as we study and learn to experience the disciplines of fasting, fellowship, giving, hospitality, prayer, Sabbath, service, study, tithing, witness, and worship. Teacher: Rev. Stephen Ministry - This program teaches lay people to minister one-on-one to people experiencing grief and loss.
